And the said Thomas Drake for himself his heirs &c. doth hereby covenant and promise and agree to and with the said Patrick Rose, trustee, his heirs &c. & assigns forever in manner and form following that is today that the said Thomas Drake and Mary, his wife, their heirs &c. the aforesaid mentioned Land & other property hereby conveys unto the said Patrick Rose, his heirs & assigns against all persons whatsoever do warrant and defend by these presents upon Trust Mustered that the said Patrick Rose or his heirs &c. shall permit the Thomas Drake to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of all the property herein contained or intended to be sold or conveyed notwithstanding the profits thereof to his own profit and until sufficient to be made in the payment of the said sum of one hundred dollars either in part or the whole or in part and then upon this further Trust that the said Trustee, his executors, administrators, shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment sell the highest bid or for such as public auction after fixing the time and place of sale at his own direction and giving ten days notice thereof at the Common Hall door of the County of Southampton and one hundred days previous to the day of sale and out of the money so arising from such sale shall satisfy the charges thereof and other expenses attending the same pay the said Joseph Blythe or his legal expenses to the above mentioned sum of one hundred dollars and the legal interest thereon, and the balance if any pay to the said Thomas Drake or his heirs. But if the above sum should be paid when due so that no default be made in the payment thereof, then this deed to be void and also to remain in full force and virtue. Gardner all of their right, title, and interest in and to one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing about One hundred acres to the same more or less, bounded as follows beginning at the road in the run of Mr. Miller's Bradshaw's Mill race, & run and run to Black Creek swamp, then down run of said swamp to the bed of (Known as Bowens bridge) then up the road to the first named place.
