Norfleet & Indiana V. his wife, in consideration of the sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars and fifty cents to them in hand paid by the said J. McCallum, his heirs, assigns and assigns, the following property, to wit: A lot or parcel of land at Franklin in Shenandoah County bounded South by the railroad of Shenandoah Rail Road West by Richard Barrett's land North by the lot lately owned by W. M. Munsie, and by the same lot of A. W. Norfleet and east by the said Store lot and Road or Street. Beginning at the intersection of the said Road or Street and the line of the said Rail Road and running westwardly along the said Rail Road line three hundred & thirty six feet to Richard Barrett's land thence Northwardly along said Barrett's line one hundred and fifty five feet to a lot recently owned by W.
