Noyfleet & Indiana V. his wife, in consideration of the sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars do grant with general warranty unto the said J. W. Hollins his ^{heirs} the following property to wit; A lot or parcel of land situate in Shamington County bounded South by the seaboard of Roanoke Rail Road West by Richard Barrett's land North by the lot lately owned by W. M. Munsie and by the Store lot of A. W. Noyfleet and east by the said Store lot and Road or Street.
