This Deed made the 15th day of January 1859, between Robert I. Fitch and Ann C. his wife, of the one part, and Sullivan R. Edwards of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Robert I. Fitch & Ann C. his wife do grant unto the said Sullivan R. Edwards the following property to wit: a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the parish of Southampton and containing two hundred and seventy five acres more or less being a tract of land which the said Robert I. Fitch purchased of Jesse Little by deed dated and to record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County on the 30th day of October 1856. Also the following personal property to wit: one horse, one mule, 60 head of hogs, one goat of even, one cow, and the future increase of said hogs & cows also all his house hold and kitchen furniture and farming utensils. I trust to secure the payment of a debt due Jesse Little by bond executed by said Robert I. Fitch & John M. Tuley on the 30th day of October 1856, for Eleven hundred and eighty five dollars with interest thereon. And the said Robert I.
