 This Deed of Trust was acknowledged by Robert J. Fitch, a party thereto, and a son
 & Fitch, his wife, also a party thereto, personally appeared before me Deputy
 Clerk and myself being examined privately and apart from her husband by me, and having
 the said Deed fully explained to her, she acknowledged the same to be her act and Deed,
 and declared that she had executed it willingly and does not wish to retract it.
 and thereupon the said deed was admitted to record.

This Deed made this 1st day of December 1858, between William R. Stephenson and
 Nancy, his wife, after me part, and Murt J. Davis, after otherpart, all of the County of
 Southampton and State of Virginia, W. Pittsfield, that for and in consideration of the sum of
 apparently five hundred Dollars to him in hand paid (the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged) I do
 have bargained and sold, and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto Murt J. Davis or his
 assigns one certain tract of Land near Berlin (the same upon which I now reside) lying
 in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing by estimation three hundred
 and four acres more or less and bounded as follows viz: beginning at the line separating
 the land aforesaid Wm R. Stephenson and Nancy his wife, from the lands of the Estate
 of Wm H. Stokes dec'd thence along the said Land to the line of Milton D. Butler, then
 thence along the said Butler's line, to the Oney Branch, thence down the Oney branch next
 to the publick road leading from Berlin to Smithfield, thence along the said
 publick road to Allen Stephenson line, thence along Allen Stephenson line to
 Jas. M. Ball's line, thence along Jas. M. Ball's line to Doct. Sam'l. B. Kello's line,
 thence along Doct. Kello's line to David A. Gaudens line, thence along David Gaudens line
 the publick road leading from Berlin to Petersburg, thence down the said road to the first named
 Doct. the separating line to have and to hold the above Land with all its appurtenances the
 uses and premises thereunto attached and belonging to the only use of him the said M. J. Davis
 assigns. The right and title aforesaid Land, to the said Wm R. Stephenson
 and Nancy, his wife, doth warrant generally.
