This Deed made this the 17th day of August in the year One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight between Ethelred Drake and Sally Drake, his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and Benjamin C. Cobb of the State of Alabama of the second part Witnesseth that the said Ethelred Drake and Sally Drake, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty two dollars and eight cents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and by these presents do hereby grant, sell and convey unto the said Benjamin C. Cobb to him and his heirs forever all of their undivided interest in the tract of land of which Benjamin Drury dec^d seizes and possesses and containing in all sixty acres and situated in the County of Southampton their interest consisting of one third of said land, the other two thirds of which ^{now} belong to this said Benjamin Cobb; also their interest present and reversionary in the tract of land which was allotted to Parshiba Drury widow of Joseph Drury dec^d and who since his death intermarried with Henry Daugherty the whole of said tract containing one hundred and thirteen acres and situated in the County of Southampton. And said Ethelred Drake does hereby warrant generally the land hereby conveyed.
