

This Deed made this 17th day of December in the year of our Lord 1858, between Elisha L. Ely of the first part and David H. Joyner of the second part witnesses and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and ninety dollars lawful money of Virginia, in hand paid by the said D. H. Joyner the receipt is hereby acknowledged, the said E. L. Ely covenantly doth grant unto the said D. H. Joyner a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing by survey two hundred and fifty acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows on the east and south by Blackwater River, west by Blackwater River, and the lands of Joseph Combel. North by the lands of John L. Smith and Hardy Lawrence the right to said lands is warranted. As witness, the following signature and seal this 17th day of Dec. 1858.

This deed made this 17th day of January 1859, between Joseph H. Parker of the County of Sussex of the first part and Doct. E. C. Barrett of the County of Southampton of the second part, Witnesses; that the said Joseph H. Parker has loaned and delivered as a loan and by these presents does loan and deliver as a loan unto the said Doct. E. C. Barrett the following slaves, a Niece, Mary, Anna, William, Henrietta, Lou, Charlotte, and Sam. To be held with the increase of the females thereof by said Doct. E. C. Barrett as a loan until called for or demanded by said Joseph H. Parker his personal representative or assigns. And the said Doct. E. C. Barrett hereby agrees to receive and does receive the slaves above named as a loan from said Joseph H. Parker and said Doct. E. C. Barrett hereby covenants and promises to deliver said slaves and increase of the females thereof, to said Joseph H. Parker his personal Representative or assigns when thereto requested. As witness my hand and seal this 17th Jan'y 1859.
