Joyner the following property to wit; a tract of Land lying in the County of Southampton containing about two hundred twenty five acres more or less, and occupied by A. R. Joyner doer, and by him doer of the said grant of his debts to the said granter also all their house hold and Kitchen furniture including four beds, all their stock of hogs and cattle, except of course, food for pease and potatoes, all their farming utensils and one small mare in trust to secure the following notes all executed by the said granter on the first day of June
