This Deed made this 21<sup>st</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty nine, between James R. Jaynes and William A. Jaynes of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and a Person R. Jaynes of the same County and State of the other part, witnesseth that the said James R. and William A. Jaynes for and in consideration after the sum of Eight hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Person R. Jaynes at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Person R. Jaynes his heirs and assigns forever, One undivided half of all the right, title and interest of in and to one certain tract of land and premises situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke's known as Branchville lying on each side of the Rail Road and Roanoke rail road containing by estimation thirty six acres of the same more or less exclusive of the land belonging to the Rail road company in the bounds of the said tract of land and including all the houses and other appurtenances thereto except those belonging to the said Rail Road Company, and bounded as follows, to wit; Beginning at the North side of the Rail road fifty feet from the centre of the road on the back east side of the County road, thence across the rail road and along said James R. and William A. Jaynes line of marked trees S. 12° 4' E. 19 1/2 poles to a maple; thence S. 4° E. 11 poles to a pine, thence S. 8° E. 24 poles to a pine; thence S. 7° E. 7 poles to a pine; thence S. 2° E. 16 poles to a post a corner; thence S. 83 1/2° W. 6 1/2 poles to a west end in the County road; thence N. 77 1/2° W. 14 poles to a white oak, a corner; thence N. 12° E. 19 poles to a small pine; thence N. 7° E. 8 poles to a white oak, thence N. 19° W. 8 poles to a white oak; thence S. 8° E. 17 poles to a white oak, thence N. 145 1/2° E. 16 poles to a small forked white oak thence S. 16 1/2° E. 18 poles to the County road thence along the said County road a North Easterly course to the Little Creek branch; thence down the same to the Northern boundary of the land belonging to the Rail road Company; thence along said boundary parallel with the Rail road a westerly course to the beginning; To have and to hold one half of all the right title and interest in and to the above described tract of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances thereunto belonging.
