Patton for the sum of One thousand dollars the one half cash & the balance of five equal payments of two hundred & fifty dollars each in one, two, three & four years with interest thereon from date, the receipt is hereby acknowledged that the said John A. Blacklock is to have & hold the said land free from the claim against the said Wm. A. Blacklock of any & all young person or persons whatsoever with general guarantee.
