This Deed made the Twenty second day of March in the year eighteen hundred and fifty eight, between Rebecca A. Turner and Thomas B. Powell all of the County of Smith, Sunderland, State of Virginia, Witnesses; that in consideration of thirty five hundred dollars the said Rebecca A. Turner doth grant, grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas B. Powell all her right, title and interest to two pieces or tracts of land situated in said County and bounded by the lands of Cressat Harris, Thomas B. Powell, Joshua V. Oland, and Nathaniel river, it being the land allotted to her in the division of Thomas A. Turner's estate (and the share purchased of Joseph Shale and wife containing three hundred and forty acres (more or less) are and the foregoing does not pass by this Deed. The said Rebecca A. Turner covenants with the said Thomas B. Powell that she will warrant generally the property hereby conveyed. Witness the following signature and seal.
