sum of One hundred Dollars the said William Whitehead and Anne his wife, do
grant with general warranty unto the said Robert Whitehead a certain tract or parcel
of land lying in the County of Southampton (and containing twenty eight acres more or
less) being all the lands which the said William Whitehead now has or doth have of Jordan Street
except about two acres and lies on the West side of the following line, commen-
ting at a Black gum a line tree between the tract hereby conveyed and Robert
Whitehead's land, thence running about a North East course to a Beach
tree, thence to a White Oak, thence to a sweet gum, thence to a hickory tree between
this tract and John Rose and a cem. tree for William & Robert Whitehead
