of and from the said trust; and the principal money and interest thereon
and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right, title, and interest
of the said J.R. Chamberlain and C. W. Maconbury trustees as aforesaid
for F. E. Rives, A. T. B. Merritt, and Wm H. E. Merritt in or to the same
as have and to hold the said Mchance &c. and negroes mentioned to be held
released as aforesaid with their and every of their apprentices unto the said
Lewis E. Mason his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof
of the said Lewis E. Mason his heirs and assigns forever so as that neither
they the said J.R. Chamberlain and C. W. Maconbury nor their heirs, executors,
administrators or assigns shall at any time or times hereafter have
claim pretend to challenge or demand any right, title or equity in or out of
the said premises or any part or parcel thereof and all the right title
and interest which they the said J.R. Chamberlain and C. W. Maconbury
acting as trustees of the said F. E. Rives, A. T. B. Merritt and Wm H.
E. Merritt might or could have had in, to or out of the same if by their hands
are wholly excluded and forever banished.
