This Indenture made this 15th day of April in the year 1859, between Benjamin C. Waller and Temperance his wife at the one part and David H. Thomas, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part, Whitefield that is called Benjamin C. Waller and his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said David H. Thomas at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and these of receipt and forever discharge the said David H. Thomas his heirs executors and administrators by these presents have granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm unto the said David H. Thomas and unto his heirs executors for ever a certain tract or parcel of land situate being and lying in the County of Southampton and containing twelve acres being the same more or less, bounded as follows: on the east by the Lands of the said Benjamin C. Waller and the County Road beginning on the south in a Path at Jones line running due north the road to the Flat Swamp Bridge, thence up the Swamp a few steps to the original line thence that line would and bounded by the Land on the west belonging to David H. Thomas to a white Oak tree in D. H. Thomas line thence southwest to a small white Oak corner between Nathaniel N. Thomas, Nathl. A. Jones and David H. Thomas thence south east on Nathl. A. Jones's line to the beginning to which with all the estate right, title, interest and property, claims and demands whatsoever of them the said Benjamin C. Waller and Temperance, his wife, in Law or equity or otherwise however of, in, to or out of the same. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land and every part and parcels thereof with their appurtenances unto the said David H. Thomas his heirs and executors of executors and unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said David H. Thomas his heirs and executors forever and the said Benjamin C. Waller for himself his heirs, executors and administrators and for and in behalf of the said Temperance his wife and her heirs doth warrant promise, grant and give to and will the said David H. Thomas his heirs and executors by these presents in manner and form following, to wit: That he the said Benjamin C. Waller and his heirs, the said piece or parcel of land and premises hereby granted or intended to be sold to the appurtenances unto the said David H. Thomas his heirs and executors against him the said Benjamin C. Waller and his heirs and against the heirs of the said Temperance his wife, and against all and every person or persons whatsoever will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
