one Sully & harness, all my household & Kitchen furniture of every description
25 barrels of Corn, 4000 lbs of fodder 4000 lbs of bacon a tract of
land (being a part of the tract I purchased of Martha South, containing fifty acres
more or less, all my bondys wines, & liquors of every description and my complete
inventory of all sorts, and my town of Franklin - In trust, In the first place
to indemnify & save harmless James C. Schell, Wm. A. Bell, Jos. Dillard,
Jos. A. Gillette, Jos. C. Gillette & Jas. F. Butler my securities to a note and
this day executed to Wm. W. Ruggs for the sum of Nineteen hundred & thirty
five dollars and eighty four cents - In the second place to indemnify and save
harmless Wm. J. Schell, Wm. A. Bell & Rich. D. Williams securities
to a bond executed by said Jas. A. Bell & Wm. Manfro to Alexander W.
K. filed on the 5th day of February 1856 and on demand the sum of 185
for the sum of one thousand dollars carrying interest from date of said bond, and
in the third place for the payment of all other debts due by the said James A.
Bell to which any person is security, and finally for the payment of all other
debts due by the said James A. Bell and if any shall remain that it be paid
out to the said James A. Bell.
