Gurley of the first part and Marguama Turner of the second part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid by the said Turner and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Geo. M. Gurley by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Marguama Turner all that tract or parcel of land lying on Flay and Swamp purchased by the said Gurley from Wm. C. G. Henry which heads containing about one Hundred twenty acres more or less. To Have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto her the said Marguama Turner her and heirs forever against the claim or claims of him the said Gurley or any person claiming by through or under him. This Deed made this 3<sup>d</sup> day of May 1859, between Geo. M. Gurley of the first part Edw. Maspenburg of the second part and Geo. Moore of the third part. Whereas the said Geo. Moore is bound as the security for the said Gurley as Guardian to Shos. Johnson son of Hollis Johnson which will more fully appear by reference to said Guardian bond of record in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County. And the said Gurley being willing to secure and save from loss the said Geo. Moore as his security aforesaid. Now the said Gurley with special that for the further consideration of one Dollar in hand to the said Gurley and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Geo. M. Gurley hath given and bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell to the said Edw. Maspenburg one certain negro man named Clabine with the said Maspenburg his heirs and assigns forever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said Edw. Maspenburg shall permit the said Geo. M. Gurley to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of said negro man Clabine and take the profit of said negro until default be made in the payment of said Guardian bond then so soon as such default is made, either in fact or the whole or the said Moore is likely to lose by reason of his liability as security aforesaid. The said Edw. Maspenburg shall be seen as required by the said Moore to receive and sell said negro after giving due notice of the time and place of such sale out of the moneys arising from such sale pay to the said Moore such amt. as he
