Now this indenture witnesseth that for the further consideration of one dollar
in hand to the said Earley and can before the sealing and delivery of these presents

one certain negro man named Claiborne with the said Masfenting his heirs and assigns

Claiborne and take the profit of said negro until default be made in the payment
of said Guardian bond then so soon as such default is made, either in part or the
whole, or the said Moore is likely to lose by reason of his liability as security aforesaid.
The said E. W. Masfenting shall so soon as required by the said Moore
redise and sell said negro after giving due notice of the time and place of such sale
out of the moneys arising from such sale pay to the said Moore such amt. as he is
