Whiting dec'd. and whereas said land was sold in accordance with said
decree and whereas by a further decree of said Court made at the May
Term 1859 directing the collection of purchase money for said land
and the execution of a deed for the same and whereas the said purchase money
has been collected from said Bowers the purchaser thereof. Therefore this day
make this twenty fifth day of May in the year One thousand Eight hundred and
Fifty nine, between Elliott L. Story and Elijah J. Williams Complainants
appointed by the said Court for the sale of said Land of the one part and said
Bowers of the other part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the
sum of Two thousand five hundred Dollars the said Elliott L.
Story and Elijah J. Williams do grant unto the said land Bowers

the said Hezekiah Bradshaw does grant unto the said Leonard Abbott
as trustee the following property, My tract of Land with all the appurtenances
therein belonging my growing crop on said Land & my other hold & stretched
gravel. In trust to receive Hezekiah Bradshaw in two several lots, one for
seventy Dollars bearing date the 28th day of Decr. 1857 & the other for the
Hundred & Eighty seven Dollars dated the 14th of May 1859.
