This Deed made this Thirteenth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, between Harrison J. Sope Special Commissioner appointed by a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton (at the May term thereof A.D. 1859) in the suit "Stephenson vs. Sopes" of the first part (Plaintiff) and Aburk Stephenson (grantee) of the other part, witnesseth that the said H. J. Sope Commissioner as aforesaid and by the authority conferred by the said decree for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2500 00 cents) paid by the said Stephenson to the said Sope as directed by the said decree the receipt of which sum as so directed to be paid is hereby acknowledged, doth grant and convey to the said Stephenson all that tract of land in the proceedings of the said suit described being in said County, Soppe's property to contain about four hundred acres more or less, it being the same tract on which Jno D. Stephenson resided in his lifetime and of which he died seized and is bounded by the lands of Mrs. A. E. Olund, Mrs. Martha A. Stephenson and the said A. K. Stephenson.
