This Deed made the 18th day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred & fifty seven, between Thomas Hunt and Willey Hunt, his wife, of the first part and of the County of Southampton, State of Va. and James Barnes of Bedford County N. C. of the other part, Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Twelve Dollars the said Thomas Hunt and Willey Hunt, his wife, do grant unto the said James Barnes with general warranty a certain lot of land lying in the County of Southampton, State of Va. and bounded as follows lying on the east side of the lot of land wherein the Methodist Church called Barneses now stands north of the east side of the road called the fish road embracing the lot of land where Mrs. Saly Sandford now lives containing one & one third acres be the same more or less. The said Thomas Hunt covenants with the said James Barnes that he hath done no act to encumber the said lands that the said James shall have quiet possession of said land free from all hindrances or incumbrances and that the said Thomas Hunt & Willey Hunt his wife well except such further assurances of the said land as may be required.
