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Lands of Saml. Barham, Levi C. Miller, & others containing four hundred and twenty acres and
 one negro woman named Fanny, one mule, one horse, eight head of cattle, eight
 head of hogs, Buggy & harness, four feather beds, stoves & furniture, one Broom
 Duck, Saddle, two Dining (blatant?) tables, grinders, sewing chairs, two saddle
 horse & ox cart, kitchen furniture, consisting of pots, Spiders, Trays, bread
 glass & cooking ware, growing crop of corn cotton, peas & crop of broad
 sides & sixty side creek parcels of for sowing fruit, shot gun & pistol, a
 clock, farming utensils, plow gear, &c. &c. The said Benja. C. Everett do hereby
 run and defend the title of the said property to the said Bennett Briggs.
 In testimony whereof place and clasp to secure an account due to George R. Briggs for money
 Dollars due 25 Dec 1859. I place and clasp to secure to Samuel Drury
 the following bonds & amounts, one due 20 March 1859 for one hundred dollars
 one ditto due 25 July 1858 five hundred and eighty-nine dollars & eleven cents, one
 ditto due with interest from 1 day Jan'y 1859, dated July 1st 1859 for thirty
 five dollars and twenty one cents - 3rd place and clasp to secure one bond
 for two hundred dollars to Bennett Briggs due about last February. 4th place
 or clasp to secure to William C. Drives bond for forty nine dollars & seven pence
 cents due about 25 Dec 1855. one bond due Jas. C. Peters for fifty dollars
 & twenty five cents due Jan'y 1859, one bond due Thos. M. Pearson for one
 hundred and fifty three dollars due 25 Dec 1855 one account due to
 A. Briggs for fifteen dollars due 1 Jan'y 1859, balance due on note due
 to Wm. Taylor due 1 Jan'y last, one account due Patrick M. Booth for thirty
 five dollars due 1 July 1859, one account due Jas. Roseman for eleven
 dollars, one account due Jas. C. Schell for about thirty or thirty five dollars
 balance due on note due James Williams about forty dollars due some
 years ago, one note due to James M. Mangum for one hundred and seven dollars
 due Jan'y 1858, one note due Joseph M. Barham for thirty dollars due
 1 Jan'y 1859, one note due Fortunatus Dunn for twenty five dollars
 due Feb 1859, one note due Edward P. Dumas for about twenty dollars
 due 27 Dec 1858, one note due to Wm. Dr. Everett for one hundred and fifty
 dollars due March 1855 to secure 5th place or clasp three bonds
 to Samuel Drury which I stand as security to William Dr. Everett
 four one bond due 25 Dec 1858 for seventy six dollars and fifty
 cents one ditto due 25 July 1858 for six hundred and six pence dollars
 and seven pence one ditto for seventy nine (\$79.50) dollars & fifty cents due
 25 Dec 1859 or so much of the said bonds as may not be paid out of
 the said Williams M. Everett's estate - the said Bennett Briggs shall permit
 the said Benja. C. Everett to remain in peaceable & quiet possession of
 said property till default be made in part or whole of said bonds
 then in this further trust the said Briggs shall & will after the happening
 of such default of payment at the request of any of the said claimants make
 sale of the said property after giving proper notice of the time and place
 giving six months credit and pay over to the said parties as herein seems
 agreeable to the priority of said parties as claped and the balance if any
 pay over to the said Benja. C. Everett.
