This Deed made this 22nd day of June in the year 1857, between Peter Edwards and Marcipha his wife of the one part and John Whitehead of the other part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Three thousand six hundred and eight Dollars and 1/100 the said Edwards and wife do grant unto this said Whitehead a parcel of Land containing by late Survey 656 acres being a portion of the tract lying on the North side of Meherrin River in the County of Southampton sold by John R. Chambers, Richard H. Baker Jr & Edward W. Frazerburg unto under a decree of the Circuit Court of Southampton in the suit of Johnson and others against Brantley & others known as the Enterprise Saw Mill tract, and formerly belonging to A. P. Smith bounded as follows Beginning at a Cypress standing in Powell's branch a new corner for said Edwards in said Whitehead's line, thence along a new line between the parcels S. 70° W. 11 poles to a post oak thence S. 8° W. 77 poles to a Sweet gum, thence South 3 1/2 poles to a pawpaw gum at the run of the housefield Swash, thence down the run of said Swash 75 poles to 3 ash trees thence S. 13 1/2° E. 15 1/2 poles to a small Water Oak; thence S. 41 1/2° W. 20 poles to a Sweet gum; thence S. 31° W. 6 poles to a Cypress standing in the aforesaid housefield Swash; thence down the run 90 poles to a Cypress; thence S. 31° W. 13 poles to a small pine; thence S. 18 1/2° W. 35 poles to a Sweet gum; thence S. 19° W. 37 1/2 poles to a Sealy bar; thence S. 19 1/2° W. 53 poles to a horn beam; thence S. 18° W. 12 1/2 poles to the run of the yellow gum; thence down the run to the Meherrin river, thence down the margin of the river to the Rail Road; thence along the rail road 112 poles to the large Swash, thence up the middle of said Swash along said Whitehead's line to the said Powell's branch; thence up the run of said branch to the beginning. And the said Edwards and his wife covenant to warrant and defend the title to the said Land hereby conveyed against themselves and those claiming under them but against the claim of no other person; as it is expressly agreed that the said Edwards is to be in no way responsible for any defect in the title to the said Land.
