This Deed made and entered into the fifteenth day of July in the year of our Lord eight hundred and fifty-nine between Samuel H. Barkham of the first part, William W. Briggs of the second part, C. D. Barkham of the third part, Witherspill; that whereas the said C. D. Barkham is bound as security for the said Samuel H. Barkham in two bonds, one due to Money Debt calling for three hundred Dollars and bearing date the other due to Jonathan Doudon calling for five hundred and forty-two Dollars and fifty-seven cents bearing date July 7. 1859, and the said Samuel H. Barkham being willing to indemnify the said C. D. Barkham against any loss in said security, doth grant to the said William W. Briggs, Trustee, the following property, to wit, his entire interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land of which William F. Barkham did possess, also three negroes namely Lavinia, Susan and Allen. Intend to secure the payment of the above named debts with the condition that the said Briggs is to permit the said Samuel H. Barkham to retain the above named property in possession and enjoy the benefits arising from it until such time as the said C. D. Barkham shall direct the said Briggs, as trustee, to sell it and appropriate the proceeds to the payment of the above named debts. At which time the trustee shall after giving legal notice sell the above named property to the highest bidder for cash; then first pay all the expenses, then the debts with interest and cost and the remainder to the said Samuel H. Rockwell all his right, title and interest of, in and to the estate of James Rockwell in possession, reversion or remainder both real and personal estate, and the said right, title and interest in the said
