as security for the said Samuel H. Barkham in two bonds, one due to Money Bill  
calling for three hundred Dollars and bearing date

and fifty seven cents bearing date July 7. 1859, and the said Samuel H. Barkham being

both grant to the said William W. Briggs, trustee, the following property to wit,  
his claim interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land of which Wills F. Barkham  
Die possessed, also three Negroes namely Lavinia, Susan and Ellen intent  
to secure the payment of the above named debts with the condition that the said  
Briggs is to permit the said Samuel H. Barkham to retain the above named prop-  
erty in possession and enjoy the benefits arising from it until such time as  
the said C. D. Barkham shall direct the said Briggs, as trustee, to sell it and  
appropriate the proceeds to the payment of the above named debts at which  
time the trustee shall after giving legal notice sell the above named property  
to the highest bidder for cash, then first pay all the expenses, then the  
debts with interest and cost and the remainder to the said Samuel H.
