 for about seventy dollars. one note due William M. Everett March 1858
 for one hundred and fifty dollars. In the fifth place and class, there be
 due Sam'l Downing in which the said B. C. Everett stands as security to William
 M. Everett bond: one bond due 30th Dec'r 1858, for seventy six dollars
 and fifty cents one due 30th July 1858 for six hundred and sixteen dollars
 and seventeen cents - one due 30th Dec'r 1859, for seventy nine dollars
 and fifty cents or so much of the last named bonds as may not be paid
 out of the estate of William M. Everett. The said Powers Briggs shall
 permit the said B. C. Everett to remain in quiet possession of the said
 property until default be made in the payment in part, or in whole of
 said debts hereinbefore mentioned, then on this further trust that the said
 Briggs shall and will after the happening of such default of
 payment at the request of any of the said abovesaid creditors make
 sale of the aforesaid property, after giving proper notice of the time
 and place of sale giving six months credit and pay over to the said
 abovesaid parties as herein secured agreeable to the priority of said
 parties as aforesaid as hereinbefore stated and the balance, if any, pay
 over to the said B. C. Everett.
