This Deed made this 19th day of August in the year 1859, between John E. Appel-
white, of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia aforesaid and
Chas. F. Collier of the City of Petersburg aforesaid both of the other part,
Witnesseth, that the said John E. Appelwhite doth grant unto the said Chas.
F. Collier the following property viz: four houses, two cottages, one yoke of
Oxen, two Cows, fifty five (55) hogs, one still and applehouses on
Cotton ground, the crop of Cotton now growing on the plantation were reaped
by the said Appelwhite in the County of Southampton, the crop of cotton
now growing on said plantation, the crop of Apples now growing on said
place and all brands made from said crop of apples by the said Appel-
white and one gold Watch, the said houses, cottages, Oxen, Cows, hogs, still,
applehouses, ground, crops of Cotton, Cotton, Apples & brands thereof from being
the same now in and upon the plantation of John E. Appelwhite
in the said County of Southampton. Also two debts due by Blanks
& Dabbs as is evidenced by two checks drawn by the said Blanks
& Dabbs, payable to John E. Appelwhite on order on the Exchange Bank
of Virginia and dated Clarksburg, one on the 12th day of Feb. 1859
in the sum of two hundred dollars and the other on the 18th Feb.
1859 in a like sum of two hundred dollars.

In trust to secure the payment of these negotiable notes executed by
the said John E. Appelwhite to Ro. F. Lester of the City of Petersburg,
all dated Petersburg August 19th 1859, and payable one at Sixty
days in the sum of one hundred and sixty five Dollars, the second Ninety days
in the sum of two hundred & fifty Dollars and the third at one hundred &
ten days in the sum of three hundred Dollars.

But the said John E. Appelwhite covenants that he shall remain
possessor of and enjoy the use of said property hereby conveyed, except
