

This Indenture made and entered into this eighth day of September One thousand eight hundred and fifty nine, between Alfred Griffin of Southampton County Virginia, of the first part and J. J. Daugherty of Guilford County, N.C. of the other part, witnesseth that the said Alfred Griffin is indebted to Abram Riddick and Samuel D. Albinson both of Guilford City, N.C. as follows to Riddick the sum of thirty two dollars and to Albinson the sum of thirty two dollars and by note dated Sept 1. 1859 to Sam D. Albinson in the sum of thirty two dollars and due by note dated with this Indenture, both of which debts the said Griffin is desirous should be paid and also desires to save the said parties harmless free from damage by reason of the suretyship. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and the sum of one dollar paid by J. J. Daugherty trustee to the said Alfred Griffin, the receipt of which is acknowledged, the said Griffin have given, granted, bargained and sold unto the said J. J. Daugherty trustee the following property viz: 2 Doves of these increase thirteen shooks, one cart, wheels & gears, one plow & plow gear one side board 2 Day chairs all my household furniture all my working tools cooking utensils &c also all my growing crop inside County of Southampton, State of Virginia consisting of Corn, Cotton, peas, potatoes &c To have and to hold all the aforesaid property unto the said J. J. Daugherty trustee and his heirs forever upon trust inevitably that the said Alfred Griffin is to remain in quiet possession of all the aforesaid property until required by the said Riddick & Albinson to be sold hereupon the J. J. Daugherty trustee shall advertise for ten days, all the aforesaid property and on the day of sale if the sale is not otherwise satisfactory sell all the aforesaid property and first after paying all costs pay the aforesaid Bonds to the said Riddick & Albinson of the balance pay over to the said Alfred Griffin.

Dutton, Johnathan Darden and the heirs of Edwin Hicks, and the title to which he the said Helms and his heirs will forever warrant and defend against himself, his heirs and all other persons whomsoever together with all appurtenances thereto appertaining, and the said Helms having bargained with and granted to the said Dutton and his heirs all his right, title and interest forever in the aforesaid tract of
