This Deed made the 28th Day of September in the year Eighteen hundred & fifty nine 1859, between Richard H. Gwathney of the one part and Robert B. Britton of the other part, all of the County of Southampton, Virginia, that the said Richard H. Gwathney doth grant unto the said Robert B. Britton the following property viz: All of my present crop of Corn, fodder, & Potatoes, Horses, Cattle, few hocks & Stock of Hogs 14 in number. And trust to secure at Bond held by Robert B. Britton bearing date September 28th 1859 & amounting to (\$185.33) one hundred and eighty five & 3/100 Dollars; also to secure a Bond held by R. F. Morris given in 1858, amounting to not more than \$40.00, after the Bond held by Robert Britton has been liquidated, As witness our Hands & seals the Day and Date above mentioned.
