Whitfield and George Briggs there being five or seven eighth acres in the County of Southampton, Virginia, the nature of this deed is this the land formerly belong to Henry Bishop and was sold at his sale the said being settled and no deed being given etc being the first legatee in the will of the said Bishop take the liberty of giving a deed for the said land at the price it sold for at the sale that being five dollars and twenty five cts. per acre for which amount each in hand received from Whitfield the amount the write and title of the above named Land with all there to pertaining to him and his heirs forever. Dopes this tract and appurtenances forever one certain piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke's containing six and a half acres be the same more or less.
