and fifty nine, between Jas. J. Lindsey (grantor) of the first part and Orlinda B. Mahone
grantee of the other part, Witnesseth that the said grantor for and in consideration
of the sum of nine hundred dollars to him paid by the said grantee, the receipt of
which sum is hereby acknowledged, doth grant and convey to the said Orlinda B. Mahone the
lot and garden together with all the buildings thereon (and a small portion of
the land outside of the said lot and garden, but adjoining only a small portion
of the garden which is reserved to the said grantor, and the ditch and channel of
adjoining the lot of John Bachman) which the said Lindsey purchased of
