

This deed made the 8th day of Nov. 1807, between Lee Pelham, for the Grantor, the respect and Augustus Linn (the trustee) of the other part, All witnesses; that Thomas Lee Pelham, the Grantor, do Grant unto said Augustus Linn (trustee) a certain tract of Land lying in Southampton County Va^y containing Eighty Eight acres and a half and bounded by the lands of: Bradburn the lands of Edw. Ingram, Joseph Chance Jr. also 2 Cows of calves, Horses, fourteen head of hogs, except of course, On trust to receive Demarius L. Dole of about of the hundred dollars being then the 8th day of Nov. 1807.

Butler in a certain note of One hundred pounds, five Dollars and 80 cts. due the 1st of January One thousand eight hundred and thirty one, The Conditions of the above note are as follows, should the aforesaid ^{Wilmersmith} Pick have pay the aforesaid note, and change allowing this deed in application, then this deed to be null and void, otherwise after giving due notice by the master, he will proceed to collect cash at public auction sufficient of the aforesaid property to pay the aforesaid note and expenses. The Indians made this first day of January, 1805, between Richard L. Bache & John R. Humble Esq., Legat. U. S. Consul and Dr. R. Edwards, Masters at Birmingham arrived at the first land, and James M.
