Williams the general warranty, a certain tract of land lying within County of Southampton containing three hundred and fifty five and five tenths acres more or less (the lands situated in the County of Southampton in William County, at the east by the line of Thos. M. Williams and Augustus James, on the west by Charles Williams and the south by Thos. M. Williams).

This Indenture made and entered into on the 22nd day of November integral of one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven, between Alexander Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell his wife, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and Edward L. Campbell of the same County (his heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, and assigns) Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Edward L. Campbell before witnesses, and bearing date as aforesaid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and covenanted by these presents to have, bargain, sell and unto him their heirs, assigns, executors, administrators, and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of St. Andrew, to be and by estimation two hundred and eighty acres, be the same more or less, being the tract of land known to the said Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell as the "Harrison Plantation," and be sold to the said Edward L. Campbell as appears by the deed bearing date November 11th 1856, in the above mentioned County of Southampton and Parish of St. Andrew, the said land being more or less, the said tract of land is bounded by the land of the said Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell on the north, by the land of the said Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell on the east, by the land of the said Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell on the south, and by the land of the said Augustus Campbell and Virginia K. Campbell on the west.
