This Deed made this 26th day of January 1860, between Henry L. Henard
of the one part and Seth H. Bishop of the other part all of the County of South-
ampton, North Carolina; that whereas Henry Rix did by Deed of last date the
27th day of September 1856, and duly recorded in Southampton County land in the
same day, convey to the said Henry L. Henard as trustee a certain tract or parcel
of land lying & being in the County of Southampton bounded by the lands of Mrs.
Archibald Edmonstone, the lands of John Thomas, Henry D. Dilling,
Seth H. Bishop containing or bounded by Twenty Three acres more or less in trust
to secure the payment of a bond executed by the said Henry Rix to E. C.
Henard for the sum of three hundred Dollars payable the 10th day
of September 1856, and whereas the said Henry L. Henard by Deed
of the foregoing recd said Deed did after having duly examined the said
