This Deed made this 24th of March 1860 between Obediah Gardner of the one part and Godwin Parker Trustee of the other with respect; that the said Obediah Gardner doth grant unto the said Godwin Parker a certain tract of land lying in Southampton County containing one hundred and twenty two and one fourth acres of Land and bounded by the lands of Lawrence L. Daughtrey, Thos. Scoggins, Godwin Parker and the Potomac river. So hold the said Land in trust for the benefit of the said Obediah Gardner during his lifetime and at his death to hold the same for the benefit of his wife Polly Gardner and his children now living and their issue or any that may be born to the said Obediah Gardner hereafter.
