Vick his wife, doth grant unto the said Caswell Blount all of their entire interest in a certain piece of Land lying in Southampton County, Virginia, and bounded by the lands of Caroline Rames Caswell Blount (and James Wright) containing nine acres more or less and the said Kirby Vick (and Maria H. Vick) covenants that they will warrant generally the above piece of Land - Witness the following signatures and seals the Day (and Date above written.

This deed made the 22^d Day of November in the year 1859, between Martha S. Gay and William H. Sumner of Southampton County, Virginia; That in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars the said Martha S. Gay doth grant unto the said William H. Sumner all her dower right, Title and interest (as the widow of Simon Gay died) in and to the plantation on which the said Simon Gay died, seized and possessed and she
