Joyner hath granted unto the said Wm. H. Butler the following, to wit; One negro man named Archer one negro man named for also one negro girl named Mary Ann & child one girl named Caroline and child. I trust to secure to Patrick Dolan one bond due the 31st day of March 1860 for the sum of eleven hundred and ten dollars and also to secure Robert M. Dolan as security to Arlington Gardner as Comptroller one bond for seven hundred and twenty dollars bearing date about the 31st day of December 1859 also to secure to Patrick Dolan any other debts which may be due and coming from the said Jeremiah E. Joyner to the said Patrick Dolan or which may be due and coming from Jeremiah E. Joyner to Robert M. Dolan As Witness the following signatures and seals, the day and date above written.
