and State of Virginia, am held and firmly unto Joshua Byrnes of the said County and State
in the special sum of Two hundred Dollars current money to be paid by the said Thos. J.
Burbage to the said Joshua Byrnes conditioned as underwritten.
The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Thos. J. Burbage
has purchased of the said Joshua Byrnes a certain tract of land lying in
the aforesaid County of Southampton as shown by Deed bearing date on the 2nd
day of February 1860, which Deed from the said Joshua Byrnes is of record
in the office of the Clerk of the said County, and there being a dower on said land in the right of Ellen Scott the
wife of Carlton W. Scott the former owner of said land which dower
has not been relinquished in any previous Deed (and from which right the
said Thos. J. Burbage herein releases the said Joshua Byrnes and also
from all cost or damages whatsoever that may arise from such dower right
he the said Thos. J. Burbage herein obligates himself to pay the above sum of
Two hundred Dollars to the said Joshua Byrnes, if he the said Joshua
Byrnes shall sustain any cost or damages in consequence of such dower.
Now if the said Thos. J. Burbage shall pay all cost or damages of
said dower right or secure the same to himself, then the above obligation
to be void, taken to remain in full force and virtue.
