This deed made this fifteenth day of June in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty, between Rebecca V. Blaw, Thomas J. Dutton and Henry S. Howard of the first part and J. Marsden Smith and William H. Smith of the other part, witnesses, that whereas the said Rebecca V. Blaw did by Deed of Trust dated January 6th A.D. 1855, and admitted to record in the Clerk's Office of the County and of Southampton on the 7th day of January A.D. 1855, convey to the said Henry S. Howard as Trustee a certain tract of Land (in the interest of the said Rebecca V. Blaw therein) she being at that time the wife of Henry Blaw (who the said Henry Blaw) has since departed this life) to secure the payment of a certain debt to the said Dutton; and whereas the said debt has been fully paid and satisfied to the said Dutton, which satisfaction is hereby acknowledged; Now this deed witnesseth that the said Rebecca V. Blaw, Thomas J. Dutton and Henry S. Howard, for and in consideration of the premises and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to the said Rebecca V. Blaw by the said J. Marsden Smith and Wm. H. Smith paid the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged by her, do grant and convey to the said Marsden Smith and Wm. H. Smith to be held by them jointly and equally all that tract or parcel of Land in the said deed of Trust mentioned or all of the right title and interest of the said Rebecca V. Blaw, T. J. Dutton and Henry S. Howard therein supposed to contain three hundred and eighty five acres more or less, and bounded by North by the Lands of Thomas Dudley, East by the Pottery river, South by Osborne Vick, Tucker Vick and John M. Guilford. And west by Rich H. Bishop the said tract of Land lying in Southampton County.

And the said grantors hereby grant and convey all such right, title and interest as may be vested in them and no other. Witness the following signatures and Seals this fifth day of June A.D. 1860.
