 forty (1860) between Robert S. Birtlow and Isabella H. Birtlow his wife,  
 of the first part and William J. and Jordan Beal of the second and said witnesses  
 doth, that for and in consideration of the sum of seventeen hundred & Dollars  
 to him in hand paid the said Robert S. Birtlow and Isabella H. his wife  
 doth grant unto the said William J. and Jordan Beal all their right, title and  
 interest to a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation  
 three hundred and twelve acres more or less, being in the County of South-  
 ampton lying on the west side of Postway Swamp and bounded as follows;  
 Commencing at a red oak in White's line near the Mill pond running  
 nearly Southward to a tree line to a line near the end of Mill pond from  
 thence a new line of marked trees to a black gum by the side of the road  
 of Postway Swamp, from thence the main line of said swamp to James  
 Jenkins' line, thence a line of marked trees dividing it from the land  
 of said James Jenkins and Whites land to the beginning.
