Cobb, Commissioner appointed by a decree of the other part, Whitfield, that for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and sixty five dollars (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) the said William W. Cobb by the authority (and in obedience to a decree) of the County Court of Southampton County in the said of Branch v. Branch his heirs forever the tract of Land of which Wm. Branch died seized and possessed containing by estimation one hundred and sixty six acres - And the said William W. Cobb doth hereby warrant & specify the title to the said Land with the following Signatures and Seals.

Brister all their right title and interest to one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation one hundred and sixty six acres be the same more or less, bounded by round hill Swamp, Richard M. Stephenson, Murder Stephenson, and other lands. It must be deemed Whittier W. S. special as security to the following debts, one debt due Alfred Stephenson amount forty Dollars due the 19th day of September 1859 one debt due Robert Westmore amount four hundred and twenty five Dollars due the 24th day of September 1859, with the following signatures and Seals.
