 consideration of the sum of thirty dollars the said Thomas J. Bristol
 John W. Hedges, Jane his wife, and Wilton Hedges doth grant
 unto the said Miles Washington all their right, title and interest to a certain
 tract or parcel land containing by recent Survey forty eight acres be the same
 more or less it being a portion of the tract of land made over in a deed of trust by
 the said John W. Hedges and Jane his wife to the said Thomas J. Bristol
