Cutler of the same County and State of the other part: Witnesseth that the said Joel Vick and Ann Frances, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Goodwin D. Cutler at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof, is hereby acknowledged Have granted, bargained and sold by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto him the said Goodwin D. Cutler his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parcel of said Squire's Containing five and half acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning in the road at a corner for said Goodwin D. Cutler, Richard E. Stuy and Mrs. Rebecca Vick's Down Land thence along said Goodwin D. Cutler's line N. 55° W. 8. poles to a post oak thence S. 72° W. 28 3/4 poles to a dead pine, thence N. 13° W. 24 1/2 poles to a pine at corner for the land formerly owned by John Hamell dec'd. thence along J. Hamell's line N. 87° E. 50 poles to the said road at corner in Mrs. Rebecca Vick's Down land; thence her line along the road to the beginning.
