This Deed made the 20th day of August in the year 1860, between Nathan Holmes of Southampton County, and State of Virginia (the grantor) of the one part and James Holmes of the said County and State aforesaid (Trustee) of the other part; Witnesses; that the said Nathan Holmes, Senr. (grantor) doth grant unto the said James Holmes (Trustee) the following property, to-wit: All of his present crop consisting of corn, fodder, peas, cotton &c. also his stock of hogs. In trust to secure a debt due by bond to Lucius Lawrence of Isle of Wight County and State of Virginia for the sum of Fifty Seven & 15 ct. Dated the 21st day of June 1858. The said Nathan Holmes Senr. (grantor) do covenant and indemnify the said James Holmes (Trustee) from and against all and singular claims in trust. Witness the following Signatures and Seal
