Gurley hath granted, bargained and sold & by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Wm. T. Glover his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of land situated near the Cypress Bridge & bounded on the North by the low grounds of Nottingham & the West by the Land of Oly. A. Phillips, on the South by Still St. Bishop & on the East by the Land of Jno. M. Gurley supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same more or less. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Wm. T. Glover his heirs and assigns forever against the claims of the said Jno. M. Gurley his heirs and assigns forever. Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one Dollar in hand paid by the said E. M. Masfentling at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said Wm. Glover hath given, granted, bargained, sold (and conveyed and by these presents doth give, grant, bargain and sell unto the said E. M. Masfentling his heirs and assigns forever, one certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton situated immediately on the Nottingham river low grounds near the Cypress Bridge containing one hundred acres more or less & bounded
