This Deed made this 30th day of August in the year 1860 between Jeremiah E. Sargent of
 the first part, and Henry S. Howard, trustee of the second part, witnesses, that the said
 Jeremiah E. Sargent hath granted unto the said Henry S. Howard trustee the following prop-
 erty, to wit: One negro man named Archer, one negro man named Joe, also one negro
 girl named Mary Ann and her child, and one negro girl named Caroline and her child
 which negroes are conveyed in a Deed of trust executed by the said Jeremiah E. Sargent
 the 24th of March 1860 to Wm. H. Sargent trustee, to secure Patrick D. Dolan
 one bond due 24th day of March 1860 for the sum of eleven hundred and ten dol-
 lars; also to secure Robert M. Dolan as security to Armstrong Gardner and
 Commissioner one bond for seven hundred and twenty dollars bearing date about
 the 24th of December 1859. Also to secure to Patrick D. Dolan any other debt which
 may be due and owing from the said Jeremiah E. Sargent to the said Patrick D. Dolan
 or which may be due and owing from Jeremiah E. Sargent to Robert M. Dolan
 and also all his the said Jeremiah E. Sargent's right, title and interest in the tract
 of land left him by his father, Jeremiah Sargent, and also a negro man named
 Elisha. On trust to secure William A. Atkinson the payment of bond
 due & owing the said Atkinson by the said Jeremiah E. Sargent dated the
 30th day of August 1860 for five hundred and sixty eight dollars fifty
 five cents and the said Jeremiah E. Sargent covenants with the said
 Henry S. Howard trustee that he will warrant generally the title to the
 property hereby conveyed, and also covenants further that in case a sale
 of the property hereby conveyed he shall be entitled to a commission of five
 per cent.
