Howard all of his this year's crops, consisting of corn, fodder, peas & potatoes both sown & growing, his stock of hogs about twenty in number. In trust to secure the payment of the following debts to Milton S. Butler Trust; one bond for one hundred & ten dollars due 25th day of December 1858, & one bond for eighty seven dollars & ninety four cents due 5th of March 1859.
