This deed made this 18th day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred &
 fifty seven between Thomas Hunt and Willy Hunt, his wife, of the one part &
 Samuel Darden of the other part, all of the County of Southampton State of Va.
 Well known: that the said Thomas Hunt & Willy Hunt, his wife, for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of two hundred & twenty two Dollars in cash paid to
 the said Thomas Hunt by the said Samuel Darden, the receipt whereof is
 hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained and sold, and do by this deed
 grant, bargain, sell & convey to the said Samuel Darden that tract of land
 lying in the County of Southampton, State of Va., & bounded on the northwest
 by the road called the Doon road leading from the Pine Grove to
 Doon's bridge to Norfolk. B. Cutler's line, thence from a pine a corner
 tree a straight line along said Cutler's line to a post oak, thence
 along said Cutler's line of marked trees to a second gum, thence along
 Cutler's line to a second sweet gum, thence from said tree to the fish pond
 so called, thence up said fish pond parallel with the lot of Land
 whereon now stands the Methodist Episcopal Church called Darden
 thence along the line of said Church land round to the road on the north
 side of said Church thence up said road to the conjunction of the
 fish road & the aforesaid Doon's road containing eight and a
 half acres (and bequeathed to us by the last will & testament of said
 James D. together with all and every privilege. To have and to hold the
 said lands & all the privileges, rights & appurtenances belonging thereto unto
 him the said Samuel Darden his heirs and assigns forever in full and sole
 said Thomas Hunt for himself (and his heirs with hereby covenant &
 agree to and with the said Saml. Darden his heirs & assigns that no
 tract of land hereby conveyed together with all & every privilege, right and
 appurtenance conveyed against the blame and demand of him the said
 Thomas Hunt & Willy Hunt, his wife, and their heirs & assigns, the
 blame & demand of all & every person whatsoever shall and will by this
 deed & grant warrant & defend the said Land to the said Samuel Darden
 & his heirs.
