

This Deed made the 15th day of October in the year 1860, between Richard H. Gwaltney of the one part, and Robert B. Preble of the other part, witnesseth; that the said Richard H. Gwaltney doth grant unto the said Robert B. Preble, the following property; This years crop of Corn for the year next, 16 Head of hogs & 6 Head of cattle. In trust to sell a Bond held by Robert Preble amounting to (\$185.33) One hundred & Eighty five dollars & 33 cents and bearing date September 28th 1859. The nature of this obligation shall be such that after the above mentioned Bond shall be paid off, the residue of the above mentioned property shall be applied to the payment of a Bond held by R. T. Morris amounting to not more than \$40.00.

Belwell to him (and his heirs forever) the following tract of land by old Survey two hundred and forty two acres, bounded by the lands of James Drury, Andrew J. Francis and William S. Francis (it being the present residence of said William H. Williams) and the said Wm H. Williams does hereby convey the said tract of land to the said parties with general warranty.
