

This Deed made this the 8 day of August 1860, between James W. Edwards of the first part, and Godwin Holland & Mary his wife, of the second part, and Mary his wife James W. Edwards of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Whereas, that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twelve (\$112.00) Dollars, then and there paid by Godwin Holland and Mary, his wife, both bargain and sell and by their presence do bargain and sell to the said James W. Edwards all their right, title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton known as the Fowler tract containing one hundred and five (105) acres more or less and bounded by the lands of Mills Edwards, Meredith Holland, Matthew W. Vaughan and others. Witness the following signature and seals, this the 8. day of August 1860.
