Gwynne of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas a certain T. A. Gwynne of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia at by a certain Deed bearing date the 1st day of January in the year eighteen hundred and fifty and recorded in the Clerk's office of Southampton County, is given grant, bargain and sell unto the said T. A. Gwynne his heirs and assigns all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, and lying within the County of Southampton, together with with the tenements, premises thereunto belonging in trust for the benefit of a certain Mr. W. W. Edwards and others and by which the said T. A. Gwynne his heirs and assigns was and were empowered on failure of the said T. A. Gwynne to perform certain acts and do therein mentioned, to sell the said property or as much thereof as shall be found necessary to fulfill the purposes of the said trusts and services herein contained. And whereas the said T. A. Gwynne failed to perform the requirements contained in said deed, the said T. A. Gwynne in execution of the trust act above created did on the 20th day of April 1860, after giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale, the said property was conveyed to the said W. W. Edwards by James R. Gwynne and William A.
